GRA IS NOT UNDERTAKING ANY VEHICLE AUCTION

Off Starlets '91 Street, Accra, Wednesday, 11th December, 2024 1200GMT: The Ghana Revenue Authority (GRA) has sighted a fake media release on a vehicle auction dated December 3, 2024, purported to be coming from the Commissioner-General of the GRA. The fake media release bears the signature of the former Commissioner-General, Rev. Dr. Ammishaddai Owusu-Amoah but has the name of the **current Commissioner-General, Madam Julie Essiam**.

GRA wishes to inform the general public that the notice circulating in the public domain is **FAKE**.

There are standard procedures for the auction of vehicles and goods by the Customs Division of GRA. It is also important to note that the process of auction of **vehicles does not involve payment of a registration fee**.

The public is therefore cautioned **NOT** to make payment to any person or group of persons via any means provided in the fake media release.
